Palacio de Cristal* and Palacio de Velázquez

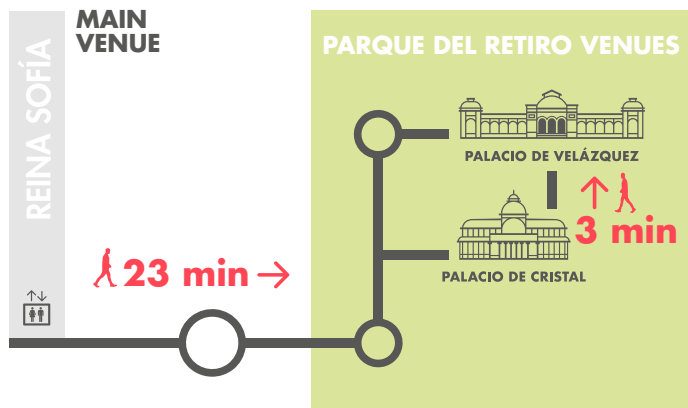

Today our future seems more uncertain than ever: we face the great challenge of the climate emergency, which urges us to unavoidably rethink our ways of life, to replace short-termism and individualism in favor of sustainable forms of coexistence that ensure our common existence on the planet. A comprehensive and coordinated reformulation that requires spaces for debate and listening that are becoming increasingly scarce amidst the noise, tension, precariousness, political and institutional disaffection as well as communication technologies that often encourage isolation and disinformation.
